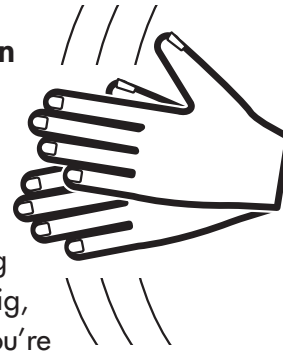
CAUTION:

Before you visit Calvary, you may want to practice this conditioning exercise:

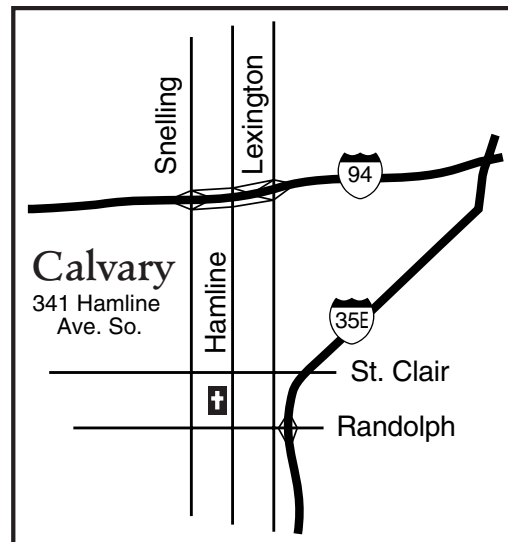
1. Extend Hand with Enthusiasm.



2. Shake Up and Down Vigorously.

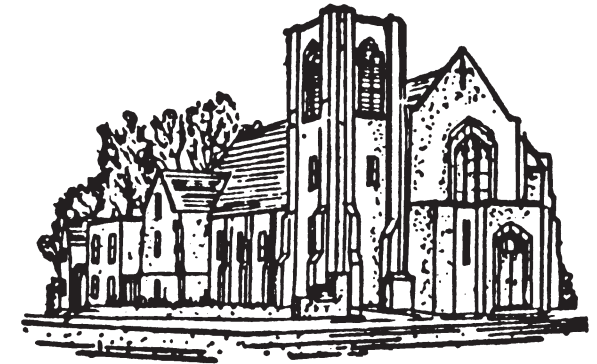

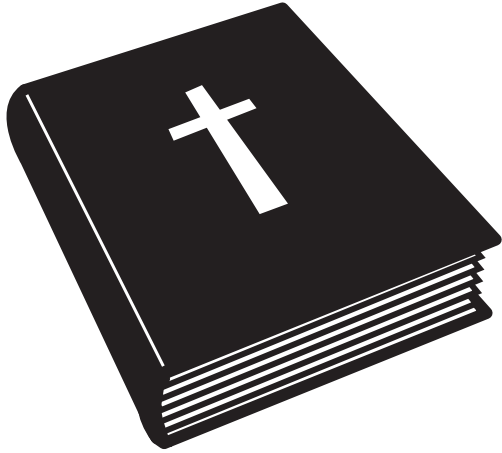
